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Rules & Regulations

- A team must arrive three (3) minutes prior to the start of their game and report to the pitch coordinator. Failure to do so will result in automatically forfeiting the match. It is the captains' responsibility to report to the pitch coordinator, and only he/she must report to the pitch coordinator.
- Each team should consist of 9 players and up to an additional 3 reserves.
- A minimum of 5 players is required to begin a game and only one substitution is allowed per game.
- Late arrivals will only be allowed to join a match with the referee's consent.
- The server must deliver the serve with one foot in the service box without touching any of the lines in the box.
- Any ball, including the serve, falling on the lines will be considered as legal or 'in'.
- A second touch is only considered legal if the first ball is hit in the net without a foul.
- A third touch is only considered legal after the ball has been successfully retrieved from the net.
- In a case where the ball arrives close to the net, the 'nettie' may return the ball or pass it to his own team players for a second touch.
- Each team is allowed a maximum of two time outs of three minutes per match.
- Sweat and wristbands are not permitted. Long sleeves must be rolled up above the forearm.
- Captains will also be responsible for keeping track of any alterations to the original schedules.
- In the event of a match being forfeited due to non-appearance, a straight win will be awarded to the attending team.
- The referee's decision will be final. Referees have the authority to overrule line calls and ask for a point to be replayed.

Requirements

- The wearing of chains, bracelets and watches is not permitted. Rings must be taped. Long hair must be tied back.
- The correct footwear and attire should be worn on the court
- Footwear should have white or clear soles, and be no marking.
